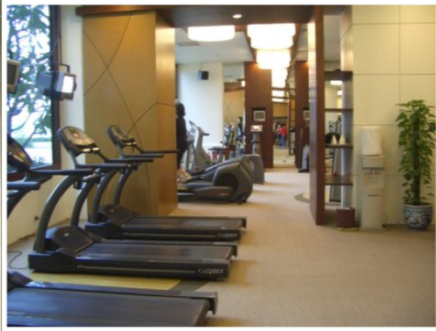

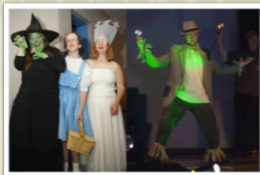

Special Needs Life Quality Plans

TERI's Life Quality Plans help protect the finances, happiness and quality of life for you and your family. We ask you the questions and you answer them. There is no need to write a long document because we do this for you. We know what is important. We also write suggested GOALS so that what you work on now will have a direct connection to the future life goals.



Special Needs Life Quality Coaching

- Special Needs Life Quality Coaches work with families to ensure that they, and their children or adults with special needs, have access to the support, encouragement, resources and knowledge to lead happy fulfilling lives.
- Coaches work with families and individuals to determine what they need in order to meet personal goals, and they establish and monitor action plans to help them reach these goals.
- Coaches are NOT counselors; they are an extension of the family devoted to improving quality of life.
