- 1. I have personal knowledge of the following facts, and if sworn as a witness, I would be competent to testify thereto.
- 2. I am, or my spouse is, a member of the United States Armed Service Reserves or National Guard.
- 3. I have a child with autism.
- 4. My dependents and I, including my child with autism, are covered by TRICARE Basic health benefits.
- 5. I learned that TRICARE Management Activity would only cover ABA therapy as a benefit under the Extended Care Health Option, which is only available to active duty service members, and therefore my child with autism is ineligible for ABA therapy benefit payments, even though I believe that ABA therapy is covered under my TRICARE Basic health benefits, as it is not special education.
- 6. Upon information and belief, any failure or delay in receiving the medically necessary number of hours of ABA therapy will probably have catastrophic developmental, emotional, and/or cognitive consequences for my child with autism.
